

# MENTORING REPORT

The students discipline and mentoring committee conducted the mentoring sessions for B.A/B.COM 1<sup>st</sup> semester on 24/09/2022. Students from both B.A and B.COM course were selected randomly but attendance was very poor. The total number of B.A 1<sup>ST</sup> semester students are 364 and B.COM 1<sup>ST</sup> semester are 140.

## Following are the findings from the students during mentoring sessions:

1. Most of the students have no basic knowledge of English. So, they face trouble in attending the classes.
2. Some teachers come late to class and their voices are also not audible.
3. The conditions of toilets is not good for both boys and girls. Sweepers do not clear the toilets regularly.
4. Most of the students are economically poor and some of the students have given up their studies after Covid 19 period.
5. Drinking water facility is not good in the Girls' hostel as well as for all students in the campus.
6. College bell does not ring at the proper time.
7. Class rooms are not always clean.
8. The students get confused with the class routine. The routine do not tally with the portal routine.
9. Some students make noises outside the classrooms during class hours.
10. Lack of sports items and a proper playground.



## ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON MENTORING
