MENTORING REPORT

The students discipline and mentoring committee conducted the mentoring sessions for B.A/B.COM 1st semester on 24/09/2022. Students from both B.A and B.COM course were selected randomly but attendance was very poor. The total number of B.A 1^{ST} semester students are 364 and B.COM 1^{ST} semester are 140.

Following are the findings from the students during mentoring sessions:

- 1. Most of the students have no basic knowledge of English. So, they face trouble in attending the classes.
- 2. Some teachers come late to class and their voices are also not audible.
- 3. The conditions of toilets is not good for both boys and girls. Sweepers do not clear the toilets regularly.
- 4. Most of the students are economically poor and some of the students have given up their studies after Covid 19 period.
- 5. Drinking water facility is not good in the Girls' hostel as well as for all students in the campus.
- 6. College bell does not ring at the proper time.
- 7. Class rooms are not always clean.
- 8. The students get confused with the class routine. The routine do not tally with the portal routine.
- 9. Some students make noises outside the classrooms during class hours.

10.Lack of sports items and a proper playground.
