Subject: Environmental Studies
Paper: ENV-AE-2014

Syllabus Guideline:

All students of B. A. 2nd Semester, Honours and Regular Courses are required to undertake a Field Work for the Environmental Studies paper where they have to undertake some of the following activities-

- a) Visit to an area to document environmental assets such as river, forest, flora and fauna etc.
- b) Visit to a local polluted site of an urban/rural/industrial/agricultural background.
- c) Study of common plants, insects and birds and basic principles of identification.
- d) Study of simple ecosystems of a pond, river, stream etc.

The students are required to submit a Report based on their findings after visiting such a place. A total of 20 marks are allotted to that report for every student in his/her final assessment as per guidelines prescribed by Gauhati University under the newly introduced CBCS pattern.

Title of the Project:

Due to COVID Restrictions on the movement and outside activities, students were asked to prepare Project Reports at home on any one of the following Topics:

1. Environmental pollution: a study in Jalukbari area.
2. A study on the ecosystem of Deepar Beel (Lake).
3. A study on the generation of solid waste in Dharapur.
4. Air pollution and its impact on the environment.

Outcome: A Total of 109 students consisting of 8 Assamese Honours, 1 Economics Honours, 8 Education Honours, 6 English Honours, 5 Hindi Honours, 3 History Honours, 11 Philosophy Honours, 17 Political Science Honours and 50 Regular course students of the B.A. 2nd Semester prepare projects on the above mentioned topics and later submitted to the concerned teacher of the EVST subject maintaining COVID specific protocols.
