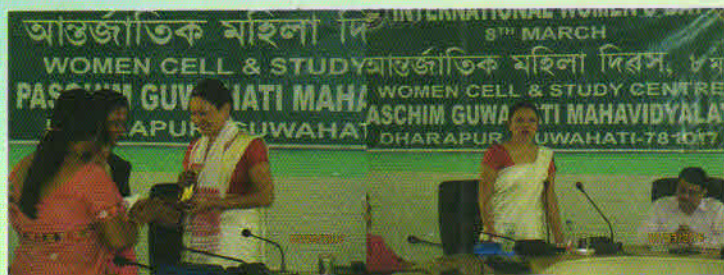
Dr. Hazarat Ali, Assistant Prof., dept. of Education becomes Convener of KKHSOU Cell in our College from this Year.
