FRESHERS' SOCIAL

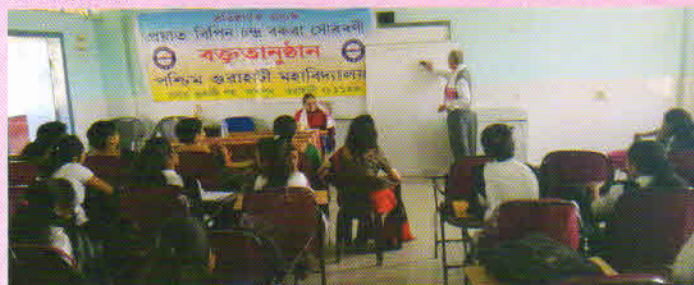

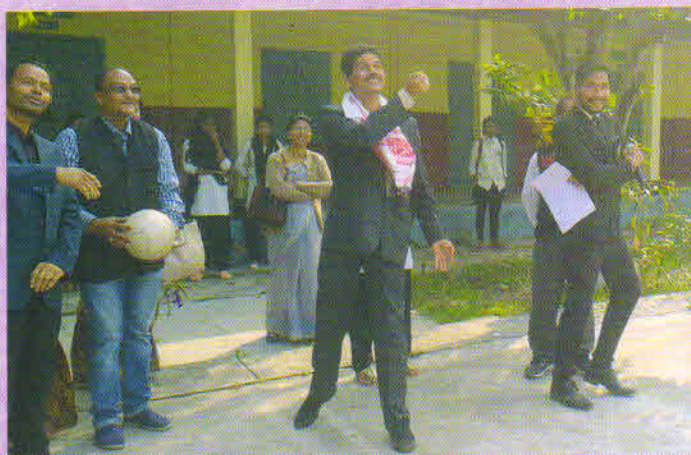
